WEEKEND REVIEW

Only one of the Premier Division's top eight at the start of play actually won. The top two met at the Perry's Crabble and, in front of more than 2,000 fans, there were no goals scored. It leaves Dover Athletic 15 points clear of Staines Town who are, in turn 14 ahead of Tonbridge Angels, 3–0 winners at fellow playoff hopefuls Carshalton Athletic. Sutton United, separating the Angels and Robins, also lost, 2–1 at Ashford Town (Middlesex). The teams starting in sixth, seventh and eighth all lost. Dartford slipped up 1–0 at home to Harrow Borough, Canvey Island went down 2–0 at Hastings United and Maidstone United lost by the same score at Tooting & Mitcham United. AFC Hornchurch remain in the playoff picture after they defeated Boreham Wood 3–1 at Meadow Park. At the bottom, it is beginning to look grim for Heybridge Swifts. They are now ten points from safety following their 3–0 defeat at Wealdstone and Harlow Town's victory, by the same score at home to Billericay Town. Hendon climbed two places, to 19th, with their 3–1 victory over Ramsgate, who are now a place below the Greens. One from bottom are Margate, who lost 1–0 at home to Horsham.

In Division One North, there were three 2–2 draws, one of which saw East Thurrock United denied victory by a last gasp goal from hosts Enfield Town. Aveley closed to within two points of the Rocks with their 3–0 win at Witham Town, and Brentwood enjoyed the

same victory at home to Potters Bar Town. Northwood slipped to fifth, behind Waltham Abbey after they were held to a 2–2 draw at Tilbury and Waltham Abbey won 2–1 at Leyton. Concord Rangers moved to within four points of a playoff spot with their 1–0 victory at home to Cheshunt, but Wingate & Finchley lost ground after losing by the same score at Redbridge. Ware are now ten points from the playoffs after they slipped up 2–1 at home to Chatham Town. At the bottom, Hillingdon Borough are nine points behind Witham Town and 18 from safety after losing 2–0 at home to Thamesmead Town. Waltham Forest picked up a point from their 2–2 home draw with Great Wakering Rovers, while Ilford had an important win, 1–0 at Maldon Town.

Cray Wanderers retained their six-point advantage at the top of Division One South as things start to become just a little clearer. The Wands won 3–1 at Sittingbourne and nearest challengers Kingstonian, Worthing and Metropolitan Police all won too, the Ks 2–1 at Godalming Town, the Rebels 4–1 at home to Whitstable Town and the Blues 2–1 at seemingly doomed Crowborough Athletic. The Crows are 20 points from safety and can pick up a maximum of 27. Fleet Town round out the top five, courtesy of their 4–0 victory at home to Burgess Hill Town, who are now in the bottom two. The Hillians are in that predicament because Corinthian-Casuals defeated Leatherhead 1–0 at Tolworth. Ashford Town's charge up the table was

slowed further by their goalless draw at Whyteleafe, while Merstham lost at Moatside for the first time in four months, Folkestone Invicta claiming the spoils with a 2–0 victory. Walton Casuals also won 2–0 away, at Eastbourne Town, while Croydon Athletic ensured Chipstead remained in the bottom four with their 3–0 home victory.

Premier Division

The biggest crowd of the season saw the top two, Dover Athletic and Staines Town, play out a 0–0 draw at the Perrys Crabble. Third-placed Tonbridge Angels were the only one of the top five to win, Dwain Clarke, seven minutes, and Jamie Cade 46 and 65, netting in their 3–0 victory at fifth-placed Carshalton Athletic. Sutton United remain fourth after losing at Ashford Town (Middlesex). Luke Pigden gave the Ash-Trees a 29th-minute lead, which was cancelled out by David Hughes, 13 minutes into the second half. Anthony Joseph snatched the winner five minutes later. Sixth-place Dartford fell to a goal from Harrow Borough's Dean Fenton after 36 minutes, a rare reverse at Princes Park.

AFC Hornchurch rose up the table thanks to a pair of goals from Simon Parker, after 28 and 63 minutes, plus an Andy Tomlinson strike 12 minutes later, as they won 3–1 at Boreham Wood. Wood's response came after 77 minutes from Louis Lee. Maidstone United lost 2–0 at Tooting & Mitcham United, for whom Dean McDonald, 25 minutes, and Kirk Watts, 89, were on target. Horsham scored after seven minutes, through Reggie Savage, and it was enough for the Hornets to win at Margate, who are now one off the foot of the table. Six points behind them are Heybridge Swifts, 3–0 losers at Wealdstone. James Gray and Greg Ngoyi scored in the first 16 minutes and Ryan Ashe got the third 11 minutes after the resumption.

Hendon rose two places, including leap-frogging Ramsgate, after beating them 3–1 at Vale Farm. Glenn Garner got the Greens' first just before half-time and Sam Collins extended the lead after 65 minutes. Two minutes later, Nick Davis halved the Rams' deficit, but Jamie Busby's last-minute penalty sealed Hendon's win. Sam Adams, after 38 minutes, and Lee Carey, eight minutes later, were Hastings United's heroes as they climbed out of the bottom four with a 2–0 victory over Canvey Island, and Harlow Town also had an important victory, 3–0 over Billericay Town, Laurie Stewart, 39 minutes, and Tom Bruno 51 and 72, the men on target.

Division One North

None of the top six lost, but leaders East Thurrock United were denied all three points at the Goldsdown Ground when hosts Enfield Town equalised in the last minute. Two goals from Martin Tuohy, a 34th-minute penalty and a second 15 minutes from time, seemed to be enough. But Ellis Remy made it 2–1 a minute later and, in the dying moments Germain Hughes made it 2–2. Aveley had no such problems at Witham Town, Joao Carlos netting after 36 and 55 minutes and Bryan Hammatt completed the scoring after 75 minutes. Steve King and Nick Symonds scored for Brentwood Town in the opening ten minutes against Potters Bar Town and Sherwin Stanley added a third in stoppage time to complete their 3–0 victory. Waltham Abbey are up to fourth after two Marc Sonntag goals sent them on their way to victory at Leyton. Daniel Gabriel did pull a goal back with 20 minutes to go, but it finished 2–1.

Northwood were involved in ding-dong tussle at Tilbury. Nathan Phillips opened the scoring for the Dockers after 20 minutes. Hugo Figueiredo equalised at the start of the second half and the Woods got their noses in front with a goal from Brad Hewitt midway through the half. But Umaru Turay levelled things up with 18 minutes to go. A John Easterford goal, on the stroke of half-time, was enough for Concord Rangers to take all three points against Cheshunt at Thames Road. But it was another disappointing afternoon for Wingate & Finchley, who went down to a solitary Andre Humphrey goal at Redbridge. Ware took the lead at home Chatham Town, courtesy of James Peagram, but the lost 2–1. Sean Avery and Marc Brooks scored in the last 17 minutes to turn the game around.

At the bottom of the table, Hillingdon Borough fell to a pair of goals from Dean Holness, after 25 and 42 minutes, as Thamesmead Town won 2–0. A last-minute goal from Derek Hawtin broke a goalless deadlock at Maldon Town and it meant Ilford went home with all three points. And Waltham Forest came back from 2–0 down to earn a draw at home to Great Wakering Rovers. Lewis Sparrow and Tom Poole scored for the visitors after 52 and 63 minutes. But Mike Ramkin reduced the arrears after 69 minutes and Joel Palmer rescued a point in the final minute.

Division One South

Cray Wanderers retained their six-point lead at the top of the table after Leigh Bremner, 37 minutes, Steve Aris, 50, and Colin Luckett, 70, gave them a clear lead at fellow promotion

hunters Sittingbourne. Sam De Bolla pulled a goal back with 17 minutes to go, but it was not enough. Kingstonian lead a group of three teams six points adrift after they won 2–1 at Godalming Town. Two Bobby Traynor goals, the first a 20th-minute penalty, the other midway through the second half, gave them breathing space, which became necessary when Kenny Ojukwu pulled a goal back eight minutes from time. Worthing trailed to Liam Quinn penalty after 15 minutes at the A2B Stadium. But four goals in the final 28 minutes, from Ross Treleaven, two, Scott Kirkwood and Lee Farrell, saw off the challenge of Whitstable Town. And Metropolitan Police had to work hard at Crowborough Athletic before winning 2–1. Jamie Byatt scored after 19 minutes for the Blues, but Tom Saunders equalised nine minutes after half-time. Liam Baitup got the winner after 61 minutes.

Fleet Town were the most comprehensive winners of the day, scoring four without reply at home to Burgess Hill Town. Eddie Smith, a penalty, Nathan Smart and Marc Anderson all scored in the opening 12 minutes, and Anderson got his second nine minutes from time. Ashford Town travelled to Church Road, Whyteleafe, and left with a point after a goalless draw. But Merstham suffered a rare home defeat, Josh Vincent and James Dryden scoring five minutes apart in the final quarter for Folkestone Invicta.

Corinthian–Casuals did their survival hopes a power of good with a second straight 1–0 Saturday victory. This time it was Tyrone Myton who was their match-winner, scoring after 52 minutes at home to Leatherhead. Roumauld Bouadji, 17 minutes, Sam Clayton, 73, and Serge Makofu, 90, were the Croydon Athletic goalscorers in their 3–0 home win against Chipstead. And, in the other match, Paul Armstrong and Gavin Bolger scored after 56 and 66 minutes, respectively, to give Walton Casuals a 2–0 win at Eastbourne Town

Ryman Youth League

With leaders of the North West Division of the Ryman Youth League without a game, second placed AFC Wimbledon took the opportunity to move three points closer with a 7–0 home win against basement club Godalming Town – Peter Rapson netting a hat-trick for the young Dons.

The night before, Walton & Hersham had a good 5–2 win at Kingstonian, whilst Woking beat Hampton & Richmond Borough 2–1. In the remaining game, the points were shared

as Carshalton Athletic drew 2–2 with Corinthian-Casuals.

In the South East Division, Tonbridge Angels opened up the week on Monday evening with a 2–0 home win against Whyteleafe. The 'Leafe youngsters were in action again two evenings later, again losing by the same score at Lewes.

This win for Lewes enabled the Sussex club to move to within five points of leaders Croydon Athletic, who lost on Thursday evening 2–1 at Worthing.

Elsewhere on the Thursday, Eastbourne Town and Maidstone United shared for goals and the points, whilst the Burgess Hill Town youngsters won 2–1 at Horsham YMCA.

In the Third Round of the Isthmian Youth Cup, Boreham Wood, who were last year's runners-up, won 3–1 at Wealdstone, and now travel to Carshalton Athletic in the Quarter-Finals.
