

ALPHN\$ - Test for Alphanumeric Character

The ALPHN\$ merely tests if a character is alphanumeric.

1. Invocation

To test a character code:

```
CALL ALPHN$ USING char
```

where *char* is a PIC X variable.

2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

No STOP codes are generated by ALPHN\$.

The following exception conditions may be returned by ALPHN\$:

EXIT code	\$\$COND	Description
1	1	The character is not in the range "A" to "Z" or "a" to "z" or "0" to "9".

3. Programming Notes

ALPHN\$ is only available with GSM SP-29, or later.

ALPHN\$ assumes a 7-bit character set.
