

## B\$BCKO – Set Window Scroll Direction Reverse

This call is used in within a window that has been entered using the B\$BACK call, which has subsequently used the B\$BCKF routine, to set the window scroll direction from normal to reverse.

### 1. Invocation

To set the window scroll direction to reverse code:

```
CALL B$BCKO
```

No parameters are required.

### 2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

None.

### 3. Programming Notes

The B\$BCKO routine is equivalent to the BACKON routine in the Global-3000 P.MIDDLE Middleware DLM library.

### 4. Examples

Consider window W1 that has been entered using a CALL B\$BACK USING W1 (i.e. rather than a normal ENTER WINDOW W1):

```
WINDOW W1
```

```
*
*   Entered in reverse direction
*
*   CALL B$BCKF           * Set direction back to normal
*   ENTER WINDOW W2      * W2 in normal direction
*   CALL B$BCKO          * Set direction back to reverse
*
*   Continue in reverse direction
*
```
