## **B\$DRGN - Return Current Generation Number**

This routine returns the current Generation Number of an I/O channel into the accumulator.

### 1. Invocation

B\$DRGN is called as follows:

CALL B\$DRGN USING \$rc

where rc is a record channel control block. Note the mandatory "\$" character in the Record Control Block parameter.

# 2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

No STOP codes are generated by B\$DRGN.

No exceptions are returned by B\$DRGN.

## 3. Programming Notes

The result is returned in the Accumulator register. A \$STORE, \$SUB etc. must be executed immediately after the CALL B\$DRGN before the Accumulator is overwritten by another instruction.
