

B\$SYNC – Synchronise GX Type-Ahead Buffer

This routine synchronises the GX type-ahead buffer, effectively clearing the internal character buffer maintained by the GX client.

1. Invocation

B\$SYNC is called as follows:

```
CALL B$SYNC
```

No parameters are expected or required.

2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

No STOP codes are generated by B\$SYNC.

No exceptions are returned by B\$SYNC.

3. Programming Notes

A call to the B\$SYNC routine (to clear the client-side type-ahead buffer within GX) normally follows a call to the CLRTA\$ routine (to clear the server-side type-head buffer).
