

# CFTGSS\$ - Copy File to Global System Manager

The CFTGSS\$ routine copies the contents of a file from the host operating system to Global System Manager.

## 1. Invocation

To copy a file code:

```
CALL CFTGSS$ USING filename unit pa
```

where filename is the filename of the Global file, unit is its unit and pa is the filename and path of the file to be copied to in a control block as follows:

```
01 PA
02 PAPHATH PIC X(99) * Path and filename terminated by #00
02 FILLER PIC X * Block terminator
VALUE #00
```

## 2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

No STOP codes are generated by CFTGSS\$.

The following EXIT codes may be returned by CFTGSS\$:

EXIT code	\$\$COND	Description
1	01	Unable to create Global file
2	02	Unable to open input file
5	05	Error closing Global file
6	06	Error closing input file
7	07	Error deleting existing Global file
8	08	Error reading input file
9	09	Error writing to Global file

## 3. Programming Notes

CFTGSS\$ will automatically overwrite any existing Global file of the same name and unit deleting the old file. The Windows (Unix) file is copied byte-by-byte to Global. The data is not reformatted in anyway.
