CFTGS\$ - Copy File to Global System Manager

The CFTGS\$ routine copies the contents of a file from the host operating system to Global System Manager.

1. Invocation

To copy a file code:

CALL CFTGS\$ USING filename unit pa

where filename is the filename of the Global file, unit is its unit and pa is the filename and path of the file to be copied to in a control block as follows:

01 PA 02 PAPATH PIC X(99) * Path and filename terminated by #00 02 FILLER PIC X * Block terminator VALUE #00

2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

No STOP codes are generated by CFTGS\$.

The following EXIT codes may be returned by CFTGS\$:

EXIT code	\$\$COND	Description
1	01	Unable to create Global file
2	02	Unable to open input file
5	05	Error closing Global file
6	06	Error closing input file
7	07	Error deleting existing Global file
8	08	Error reading input file
9	09	Error writing to Global file

3. Programming Notes

CFTGS\$ will automatically overwrite any existing Global file of the same name and unit deleting the old file. The Windows (Unix) file is copied byte-by-byte to Global. The data is not reformatted in anyway.
