

DHMSD\$ - Convert Internal Format Date/Time to Display Format

The DHMSD\$ routine converts an internal format PIC 9(9) COMP field containing the time in seconds to an external string.

1. Invocation

To convert an internal format time to display format code:

```
CALL DHMSD$ USING int-time ext-time
```

where *int-time* is a PIC 9(9) COMP field containing the supplied internal time and *ext-time* is a PIC X(80) field in which the external format time is returned.
