GXCPM\$ - Set GX Contract Protection Message

The GXCPM\$ is available to display the GX Contract Protection Message. This routine is only used by \$STARX.

THIS ROUTINE IS RESERVED FOR INTERNAL USE ONLY.

1. Invocation

To set the GX Contract Protection Message code:

CALL GXCPM\$ USING timeout text

where *timeout* is a PIC 9(4) COMP field, or literal, and *text* is the text-string **WHICH MUST BE TERMINATED WITH A BINARY ZERO** (i.e. a byte of LOW-VALUES).

2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

The following STOP codes may be generated by GXCPM\$:

| STOP code | Description | |

| ????? | GXCPM\$ has been called by an application that is not running on GX. | |
| ????? | String too large for internal buffer | |
| ????? | An attempt was made to call GXCPM\$ on an incompatible version of GX. The version of GX must be V2.7, or later. | |

The following EXIT codes may be returned by GXCPM\$.

GXCPM\$ is only available when running on GX. Any attempt to use GXCPM\$ on a non-GX terminal will result in a STOP code.
