

## **GXDCM\$ - Suppress Menu Clear**

Normally when a Speedbase window is displayed as a result of a menu selection, the menu is cleared from the screen. Under some circumstances (e.g. when entering a window that prompts for a password) it may be required to leave the menu on the screen. The GXDCM\$ routine suppresses the menu clear function that normally precedes the window display.

### **1. Invocation**

To suppress the normal menu clear before the next Speedbase window is displayed code:

```
CALL GXDCM$
```

Note that GXDCM\$ does not require any parameters.

### **2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions**

The following STOP codes may be generated by GXDCM\$:

<b>STOP code</b>	<b>Description</b>
23958	GXDCM\$ is not running on GX.
23959	GX returned an unexpected error.

No EXIT codes are returned by GXDCM\$.

### **3. Programming Notes**

GXDCM\$ is only available with GSM SP-11, or later. GXDCM\$ is only available when running on GX. Any attempt to use GXDCM\$ on a non-GX terminal will result in a STOP code.
