

GXDSO\$ - Disable the GX Settings Option

The GXDSO\$ routine is available to disable, and re-enable, the GX toolbar.

1. Invocation

To enable, or re-enable, the GX Setting Option code:

```
CALL GXDSO$ USING flag
```

where *flag* is a PIC 9(4) COMP variable, or literal, with one of the following values:

```
0    Enable GX Settings Option
1    Disable GX Settings Option
```

2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

The following STOP codes may be generated by GXDSO\$:

STOP code	Description
23952	GXDSO\$ is not running on GX.

The following EXIT codes may be returned by GXDSO\$:

EXIT code	\$\$COND	Description
23953	53	GX reported an unexpected error.

3. Programming Notes

GXDSO\$ is only available with GSM SP-10, or later. GXDSO\$ is only available when running on GX. Any attempt to use GXDSO\$ on a non-GX terminal will result in a STOP code.

GXDSO\$ may be required for applications installed at customers who “fiddle” with the GX Settings options (e.g. modifying the Label font, Data font etc. settings).
