

GXERC\$ - Change GX Error Message Caption

By default the caption on the Windows message box displayed by the ERROR function is "Error". The GXERC\$ routine can be used to change the default text.

1. Invocation

To change the default caption text code:

```
CALL GXERC$ USING text
```

Where *text* is a zero-terminated text-string.

2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

The following STOP codes may be generated by GXERC\$:

| STOP code | Description |
|-----------|--|
| 23992 | The Caption Text is too long (or not terminated by a byte of binary zero). |
| 23993 | An attempt has been made to call GXERC\$ on a non-GX screen. |

The following EXIT codes may be returned by GXERC\$.

| EXIT code | \$\$COND | Description |
|-----------|----------|---|
| 23951 | 51 | There was insufficient memory available to allocate the work data area for the GXERC\$ routine. |

3. Programming Notes

GXERC\$ is only available when running on GX. Any attempt to use GXERC\$ on a non-GX terminal will be ignored.
