

GXGCR\$ - Get Computer Reference from GXHOSTS.INI

The GXGCR\$ routine can be used to obtain the Computer Reference setting from the GXHOSTS.INI file.

1. Invocation

To obtain the Computer Reference setting code:

```
CALL GXGCR$ USING name
```

where *name* is a PIC X(100) field into which the Computer Reference setting is returned.

2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

The following STOP codes may be generated by GXGCR\$:

STOP code	Description
14203	GXGCR\$ has been called by an application that is not running on GX

No exceptions are returned by GXGCR\$.

3. Programming Notes

GXGCR\$ is only available when running on GX. Any attempt to use GXGCR\$ on a non-GX terminal will result in a STOP code.

The Computer Reference setting is defined in the [hosts] section of the GXHOSTS.INI file. For example:

```
[hosts]
HostID1=localhost,Local host
ComputerReference1=ComputerRef1
```

The Computer Reference setting is **NOT** terminated with a byte of binary-zero. If the Computer Reference setting is less than 100 characters, the remainder of the PIC X(100) field is SPACE filled.
