GXMWS\$ - Minimise Window Size

The GXMWS\$ routine is used to minimise the size of the next window by removing blanks areas to the right of, and below, the last field/button displayed.

1. Invocation

To define the next window as a Minimised Window code:

CALL GXMWS\$

No parameters are required.

2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

The following STOP codes may be generated by GXMWS\$:

STOP code	Description
15221	GXMWS\$ has been called by an application that is not running on GX.
15223	An attempt was made to call GXMWS\$ on an incompatible version of GX. The version of GX must be V2.6, or later.

No exception conditions are returned by GXMWS\$.

3. Programming Notes

GXMWS\$ is only available when running on GX. Any attempt to use GXMWS\$ on a non-GX terminal will result in a STOP code.
