GXNBT\$ - Specify No-Button Window

The GXNBT\$ routine is used to prevent GX from adding the default "OK" and "Cancel" buttons to a "button-less" window (i.e. a window that does not contain any BTN fields).

1. Invocation

To define the next window as a "button-less" window code:

CALL GXNBT\$

2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

No STOP codes are generated by GXNBT\$.

No exceptions are returned by GXNBT\$.

3. Programming Notes

GXNBT\$ is only available when running on GX. Any attempt to use GXNBT\$ on a non-GX terminal will be ignored.

GXNBT\$ should be called immediately before entering the window.

Note that there should be no need to use this routine before displaying a Display-Only window because GX will not append buttons to Display-Only windows.
