

## GXPHD\$ - Preserve GX HEADING Text

The GXPHD\$ routine can be used to preserve the current HEADING text that would otherwise be removed when the current frame terminates, and updated when the next frame executes.

### 1. Invocation

To preserve the current HEADING text code:

```
CALL GXPHD$ USING 1
```

To allow the preserved HEADING text to be updated again, code:

```
CALL GXPHD$ USING 0
```

### 2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

The following STOP codes may be generated by GXPHD\$:

STOP code	Description
23925	GXPHD\$ has been called by an application that is not running on GX.
23924	Incompatible version of GX

No exception conditions are returned by GXPHD\$.

### 3. Programming Notes

GXPHD\$ is only available when running on GX. GXPHD\$ is only available with GSM Service Pack-8, or later.
