

GXSBM\$ - Set GX Status Bar Message Text

The GXSBM\$ routine is available to set the GX Status Bar Message Text.

1. Invocation

To set the GX Status Bar Message Text code:

```
CALL GXSBM$ USING text
```

where *text* is the text-string **WHICH MUST BE TERMINATED WITH A BINARY ZERO** (i.e. a byte of LOW-VALUES).

2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

The following STOP codes may be generated by GXSBM\$:

STOP code	Description
23926	GXSBM\$ has been called by an application that is not running on GX.
23927	String too large for internal buffer
23928	An attempt was made to call GXSBM\$ on an incompatible version of GX. The version of GX must be V2.7, or later.
23929	An unexpected error has been reported by GX

The following EXIT codes may be returned by GXSBM\$.

EXIT code	\$\$COND	Description
23922	22	Unable to allocate memory for temporary work buffer

3. Programming Notes

GXSBM\$ is only available when running on GX. Any attempt to use GXSBM\$ on a non-GX terminal will result in a STOP code.
