GXSDF\$ - Set GX Documentation Folder

The GXSDF\$ is reserved for internal use only by the Menu Handler to set the GX documentation folder and documentation filename.

1. Invocation

To set the GX documentation folder and filename code:

```
CALL GXSDF$ USING index [file name]
```

where *index* is a PIC 9(4) COMP field, or literal, that specifies the numeric index (between 0 and 9) in the GX.INI file for the documentation folder; *file_name* is an optional PIC X(2) filename that defines the name of the .chm file that will be used as the documentation "compiled help" file.

2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

The following STOP codes may be generated by GXSDF\$:

STOP code	Description
23930	GXSDF\$ has been called by an application that is not running on GX.
23931	An attempt was made to call GXSDF\$ on an incompatible version of GX. The version of GX must be V2.7, or later.
23932	The index passed is invalid

No exception conditions are returned by GXSDF\$.

3. Programming Notes

GXSDF\$ is only available when running on GX. Any attempt to use GXSDF\$ on a non-GX terminal will result in a STOP code.

GXSDF\$ should only be used by the Menu Handler, \$MENU32.
