

GXSSC\$ - Set Scroll Cell Offset for Window

The GXSSC\$ routine is used to set the Scroll Cell Offset for the next window.

1. Invocation

To set the Scroll Cell Offset for the next window code:

```
CALL GXSSC$ USING offset
```

where *offset* is a PIC 9(4) COMP field, or literal, which defines the new Scroll Cell Offset. The *offset* must be between 0 and 20.

2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

The following STOP codes may be generated by GXSSC\$:

STOP code	Description
23967	GXSSC\$ has been called by an application that is not running on GX.
23968	The Scroll Cell Offset parameter is not in the range 0 to 20.

No exception conditions are returned by GXSSC\$.

3. Programming Notes

GXSSC\$ is only available when running on GX. Any attempt to use GXSSC\$ on a non-GX terminal will result in a STOP code.

The GXSSC\$ routine only affects the next window that is ENTER'ed or DISPLAY'ed.
