

## GXVER\$ - Get GX Version

The GXVER\$ routine can be used to obtain the version of GX.EXE.

### 1. Invocation

To obtain the version of GX.EXE code:

```
CALL GXVER$ USING version
```

where *version* is PIC X(6) field into which the GX version is returned.

### 2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

The following STOP codes may be generated by GXVER\$:

STOP code	Description
14203	GXVER\$ has been called by an application that is not running on GX

No exceptions are returned by GXVER\$.

### 3. Programming Notes

GXVER\$ is only available when running on GX. Any attempt to use GXVER\$ on a non-GX terminal will result in a STOP code.

The format of the string returned is always:

*Vn.mab*

where:

- n* always numeric
- m* always numeric
- a* either blank or alphabetic (upper or lower case)
- b* either blank or “+” (the “+” indicates a evaluation version of GX.EXE)

For example:

V3.4  
V3.5b  
V3.5b+
