

GXWHA\$ - Return Window Handle

The GXWHA\$ routine is used to return the Windows "Window Handle" of the current Speedbase window.

1. Invocation

To obtain the Window Handle of the current Speedbase window code:

```
CALL GXWHA$ USING handle
```

where *handle* is a PIC X(8) field into which the handle is returned.

2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

The following STOP codes may be generated by GXWHA\$:

STOP code	Description
14207	GXWHA\$ has been called by an application that is not running on GX.

No exceptions are returned by GXWHA\$.

3. Programming Notes

GXWHA\$ is only available when running on GX. Any attempt to use GXWHA\$ on a non-GX terminal will result in a STOP code.

This routine is considered highly-specialised and should not be required for most applications.
