## **WOYRX\$ - Extended Convert Internal Date to Week Number**

The WOYRX\$ routine is available to convert an internal date to a Week Number (where the Week Number is defined in ISO-8601). WOYRX\$ is an extended version of WOYR\$, allowing the first day of the week to be specified.

### 1. Invocation

To convert an Internal Date to a Week Number code:

CALL WOYRX\$ USING int\_date first\_day week\_number

where *int\_date* is a PIC 9(6) COMP field containing an Internal Date; *first\_day* is the week start day (Monday=1, Tuesday=2, ..., Sunday=7) and *week\_number* is a PIC 9(4) COMP in which the Week Number is returned.

## 2. STOP Codes and Exception Conditions

No STOP codes are generated by WOYRX\$.

No EXIT codes are returned by WOYRX\$.

### 3. Programming Notes

Unlike the basic WOYR\$ routine, the extended WOYRX\$ routine allows the first day of the week to be specified by the calling application.

The Week Number calculated by WOYRX\$ is not related to HMRC Tax Week numbers.

WOYRX\$ functions correctly both with UK format dates (\$\$USA=0) and USA format dates (\$\$USA=1).

No exception is generated if *int-date* is invalid. If a wrong value is supplied it will be mechanically converted to a Week Number.
